1. Apologies for Absence

2. Minutes of Last Meeting

The minutes of the last meeting were unavailable, however the points to be followed up on were:

Over the next few weeks, a pin code will be sent to all parents for Showbie which will allow them access to Showbie to view work if they download the app on their phone. This will be explained at upcoming parents' nights and tracking reports.

3. Race Night

4. Report from Headteacher

5. Minibus Funding Update

May want to include the low emission zone for the city, as this will impact any trips to other schools on the opposite side of the city i.e., sports matches.

6. AOB
