The Parents Portal programme has now been successfully launched in your child's school. You should have received a letter notifying you about the programme. This also included guidance on how to access Parents Portal and make the "Link to your Child" in order to enjoy the services offered by the programme.

Please refer to the link in Step 4. in the guidance below where you will find really helpful short interviews from a parent, school clerical employee and a head teacher about their experience of Parents Portal. Parents Portal provides you with instant access (24 hours x 7 days a week) to your child's school for administrative services.

One of the major benefits of Parents Portal is that you receive information about your child's school instantly and no paper is required for Annual Data Checks (ADCs) and Permission slips. The Annual Data Check exercise takes place in August and September. If you have not already done so, it would be very much appreciated if you could join Parents Portal by following the guidance below. This will help ensure you are ready to experience the benefits of Parents Portal.
