

Practical Craft Skills - National 3



Learning in this Course will be primarily practical, hands-on and experiential in nature.

The aims of the Course are to enable learners to:

- develop skills in reading and interpreting drawings and diagrams
- identify, select and use a range of workshop tools and equipment
- develop basic skills in measuring and marking out of materials
- develop basic skills in cutting, shaping, fixing and joining materials
- apply safe working practices in a workshop or similar environment
- take account of good practice regarding sustainability and recycling

This Course will also give learners the opportunity to develop numeracy and thinking skills.

Learners would normally be expected to have attained some relevant skills and knowledge through prior experience.

This Course provides progression to National 4 Practical Woodworking.

Course structure: The course has three units

To gain an award for this course, learners need to pass all three units. Each unit is graded Pass or Fail.
